 - ❑ Specialist community FTEs and beds (services for complex and low prevalence disorders such as eating disorders and severe personality disorder).
 - ❑ Methadone places

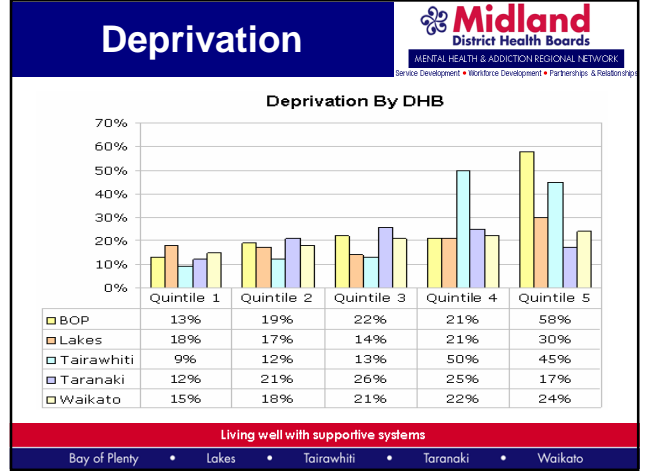
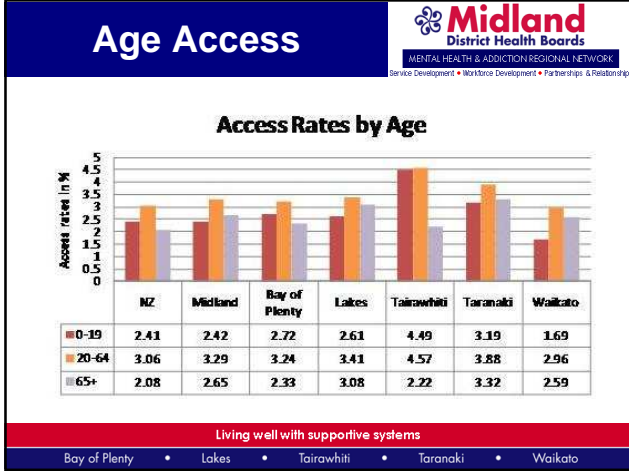
