

Gaining secure access to PRIMHD: clarification of costs for Stage 3 NGOs

Dear PRIMHD NGO decision-maker

There has been some miscommunication regarding the costs that NGO providers of mental health and addiction services will incur when establishing an electronic connection with PRIMHD.

Please be aware that all NGOs have to bear their own costs in gaining secure access to PRIMHD.

Because PRIMHD can only be accessed via the Health Network, NGOs can only gain access to the Health Network via an accredited secure network service. While the Health Network itself is free of charge, NGOs will need to pay an accredited commercial service vendor to gain access to the Health Network.



The Health Network Governance Board (an operational unit of the Ministry of Health) is responsible for accrediting commercial network services that meet the prescribed level of secure operation.
